The committee was created by legislation passed during the 2013 Regular Session of the Nevada Legislature (AB 360).

Charged with studying the impact of modern and evolving technology upon gaming and the regulation of gaming, the committee will look at issues presented by interactive gaming, the expanding capability of portable and personal electronic devices, and the potential effects of the authorization of entity wagering on sports.

The committee is comprised of six voting members -- three members of the Nevada Senate and three members of the Nevada Assembly -- and seven non-voting members, including the Chairmen of the Nevada Gaming Commission and the Gaming Control Board and five industry representatives.

“I look forward to serving on this important committee as it examines some of the most significant regulatory challenges facing our state’s largest business sector,” said Brower. “It is critical that Nevada continues to lead the way on cutting-edge issues that affect every part of the gaming industry.”
