

**SNELL & WILMER PARTNER GREG BROWER NAMED CHAIRMAN OF THE  
NEVADA SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE**

**LAS VEGAS (Nov. 7, 2014)** – The Nevada Senate Republican Caucus announced this week that Snell & Wilmer partner and Nevada Senator Greg Brower will become the new chairman of the Judiciary Committee of the Nevada Senate. Republicans won a majority of seats in the Nevada Senate in Tuesday's elections for the first time since the 2006 elections.
