GOVERNOR JOHN HICKENLOOPER REAPPOINTS SNELL & WILMER ATTORNEY JASON B. BRINKLEY TO GREAT OUTDOORS BOARD OF TRUSTEES

DENVER (September 11, 2017) – Snell & Wilmer is pleased to announce that Governor John Hickenlooper has reappointed Denver attorney [Jason B. Brinkley](#) to the [Great Outdoors Colorado](#) (GOCO) Board of Trustees. Brinkley was originally appointed to serve on the board of trustees by Governor Hickenlooper in 2013. Since then, Brinkley has served on the GOCO board in a variety of positions, and currently serves as chairman. If confirmed by the Colorado Senate, Brinkley's new term will expire in 2021.

"I am honored to be reappointed to the GOCO board by Governor Hickenlooper," said Brinkley. "I look forward to continuing my work with GOCO staff, partners and fellow board members to protect Colorado land; connect people to parks, trails, and nature; and inspire the next generation of Coloradoans to get outdoors."

Since its creation in 1992, GOCO has conserved more than one million acres of Colorado open space, created or enhanced more than 1,000 community parks and outdoor recreation areas, built or restored more than 900 miles of trail, and protected more than 750 miles of rivers. Through its partnership with Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW), which receives half of GOCO funding, GOCO has also helped add more than 47,000 acres to the State Parks system and assisted CPW in acquiring and improving wildlife habitat across Colorado. Throughout its history, GOCO has granted over \$1 billion to fund more than 4,800 projects in urban and rural areas in all 64 counties in Colorado.
