In 2019, Nigro was awarded the Phoenix Business Journal's Health Care Hero Philanthropic Champion award for acting as a sighted guide for the Blind Buccaneers, a group of blind and visually impaired students from the FBC who sailed around the Spanish Virgin Islands. Also a member of the National Organization for Albinism and Hypopigmentation, Nigro organizes fundraising activities and helps award scholarships to college students who have albinism.
