## Main Bio

Daniel Seabolt focuses his practice on commercial litigation, including matters involving breach of contract, business torts (e.g., fraud, defamation, tortious interference, unfair competition), and disputes involving trademark infringement, real property, construction, church litigation, and the Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA). Daniel also assists in appeals work, having briefed matters before the California Court of Appeals, California Supreme Court, and the Ninth Circuit.

In addition to his work for firm clients, Daniel maintains a busy pro bono practice, leading to the Snell & Wilmer's Pro Bono Award in 2019. Among other things, he has assisted indigent individuals in the areas of veteran disability benefits, landlord/tenant disputes, home remodeling contract disputes and fraud, and has assisted in inmate appeals involving 42 U.S.C., § 1983 claims and ineffective assistance of counsel.
